Hyper poetry. Hypertext poetry and hypertext fiction are new genres of literature that use the computer screen as medium, rather than the printed page. The literary works rely on the qualities unique to a digital environment, such as linked World Wide Web pages or effects such as sound and movement.

Rhyme. Rhyme can make an important contribution to the overall impact of a poem and it is such a feature of poetry that often people expect poetry to rhyme, even though much of it doesn 't. Like several of the other features that we have looked at, rhyme is quite easy to spot but it is rather more difficult to explain what effect it has on a poem.
