Depending on the laws of the jurisdiction, eviction may also be known as unlawful detainer, summary possession, summary ...

The high rates of evictions have significant long-term consequences, particularly among children. Eviction has been linked to homelessness, substandard housing conditions, job instability, school instability, and depression.
